**Destination:** Annapolis Rock (elevation (1700'))

**Access Point:** Parking lot on Route 40, one-quarter mile east of Greenbrier. Follow blue blazed trail from parking lot to white blazed A.T. Turn right to go north on A.T.

**Difficulty:** Moderate

**Distance:** 2.2 miles

**Options for Return:** Return by same trail to Route 40

**Highlights:** Annapolis Rock offers a fine view of Greenbrier Lake and Cumberland Valley to the west. Continue north on A.T. one mile to Black Rock, which also offers a westward view.

### **Important Information**

**Everything we need will be carried in within a backpack. Boys will need to have a backpack with a frame (internal or external makes no difference for this activity).**

**The troop has access to backpacks if any boy needs one.**

**Patrols will function as a unit and will share food and troop tents.**

**Light weight sleeping bags or wool blankets are needed.**

**A sleeping pad is a must.**
